

With 30 university and college partnerships, the company develops customized university group programs, which take place during semester breaks in winter or summer.

Role of the Manager/Director

Key Responsibilities

- Manage and strengthen existing relationships with education abroad staff, faculty, and other administrators with the goal of both increasing enrollments and the number of programs approved by universities.
- Provide continuous and high-quality customer service to current and future partner universities.
- Develop and sustain new relationships with education abroad staff, faculty, and other university administrators.
- Maintain detailed records of all activities related to institutions and manage institutional profiles in CRM.
- Represent the company at national and regional professional conferences.
- Plan, prepare, and manage advisor site visits.
- Prepare and manage the invoicing process for customized group programs.
- Expand the list of university partners by introducing programs and by signing Memoranda of Understanding ("MOU") with universities who do not currently have an institutional relationship with the company (increased responsibility in this area if full-time).
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree.
- Minimum 3-5 years of experience working in Education Abroad, Institutional Relations, or a related field.
- Fluency in written and spoken English.
- Familiarity with the U.S. higher education system.
- Facilitator; outstanding interpersonal communication skills.
- Growth-oriented.

- Conscientious, honest, hard-working.
- Able to work independently but also a team player.
- Able to multi-task and meet deadlines.
- Candidate must be based in the United States.

Compensation

If the candidate is hired at half time, the salary will range between 40-50k/year, and the position will oversee the existing portfolio of university partnerships (90% of time), and develop new partnerships (10% of time). Benefits will be provided.

If a full time candidate is hired, the salary range will be 60-80k/year, depending on experience, and the development and curation of new institutional partnerships will increase to 60% of the job. Benefits will be provided.
